Activity Name	Overview
Morning class	This is the first activity in a day. The teacher takes the children's
meeting	attendance and conducts a health observation. The teacher informs the
	children of the day's activity plan so that they can have an idea of what
	to expect.
End-of-the-day	Do this at the end of the day. Reflect on what they did that day so that
class meeting	the children can have a sense of anticipation for the next day.
One-day class	The children take turns doing their roles, which is called "one-day class
coordinator	coordinator." The children who are on duty help the teacher. For
	example, they are expected to come forward with the teacher to greet
	the peers in the morning and hand out items. This is an activity that is
	connected to one-day classroom coordinator activities in primary
	school, and aims to foster a sense of responsibility.
Lunch together	This is an activity that aims to form desirable eating habits for a lifelong
	healthy life. Here, the children learn a) basic lifestyle habits (e.g.,
	washing hands before eating), b) eliminating likes and dislikes and
	enjoying eating, and c) respecting food.
Cleaning	By cleaning up in person, the children build a foundation of social
	norms to keep not only their surroundings clean, but also public places
	clean. By working together with their peers, they will also develop a
	sense of cooperation.
Communication	Every day, the children should bring the note as their own attendance
notebook	record.
	It is used for communication between the teachers and parents. It is an
	activity to let the parents know how their children are doing in KG, and
	at the same time for the teachers to check how their children are doing
	at home.
Learning	A 70-minute activity conducted in the fourth period.
through play	One of the typical activities is the "sand play activities."
